

What is FIP?

The [International Pharmaceutical Federation \(FIP\)](#) is a global body representing over 4 million pharmacists, pharmaceutical scientists, and pharmacy educators that works to meet the world’s healthcare needs. World Congress of Pharmacy and Pharmaceutical Sciences is the annual meeting for the organization. The theme for FIP World Congress 2025 is “Pharmacy Forward: Performance, Collaboration, and Health Transformation.” The congress will explore how pharmacists can drive forward the performance of healthcare systems, foster meaningful collaboration across sectors, and catalyse transformative changes in health outcomes globally. The congress is structured around three subthemes, each addressing key facets of this overarching theme. This year’s subthemes are 1). Making it sustainable; 2). Making the system work; and 3). She is a clinical pharmacist with UMMA Community Clinic and a Masters in Global Medicine student. Dr. Moosvi is a passionate advocate for increased access to medications and ambulatory care pharmacy services in underserved communities. Her interest in global health stems from her efforts in improving health equity in South Asian communities. She has served as an international consultant pharmacist with doctHERs in Karachi, Pakistan, where she aided rural areas in obtaining authenticated medication. She has also completed pharmacy work in other areas of Pakistan, Turkey, and the United Arab Emirates.</p>

	<p>Dr. Moosvi attended the FIP Congress in Abu Dhabi, U.A.E., as a VCU SOP student and returned to the Congress in Seville, Spain, in 2022 as an alumna. She found the experience transformative in expanding her knowledge and skills in the arena of global health. As such, she generously funded the Arzu F. Moosvi Global Medicine Travel Award, which will fund one VCU SOP student annually to attend the FIP World Congress.</p> <p>This \$3,500 travel award will cover the cost of registration, flights and lodging. Flights and registration will be booked on your behalf. Students will be required to front the expenses for lodging, airport transfer, and incidentals; reimbursement will be provided within 30 days of submitting your receipts. Additional student funds may be necessary to cover additional expenses. VCU SOP P1 and P2 students in good academic standing and with an interest in global health are invited to apply. The winner of the award will be selected by a panel of VCU SOP faculty and staff based on merit and need.</p>
